

First Conditional

We use first conditional to talk about real and possible situations.

If it rains this afternoon, I will stay home.

If + Subject + Present Simple + ... + , + Subject + Will + Base Verb + ...

Present Simple + Will

What is the difference between the "infinitive" and the "base verb"?

The infinitive is WITH "to": to eat

The base verb is WITHOUT "to": eat

You can also change the order of the sentence, you just remove the comma.

I will stay home if it rains this afternoon.

You can also change "will" to "can", "shall" (usually for questions), or "may".

If I'm free this afternoon, I can go shopping.
