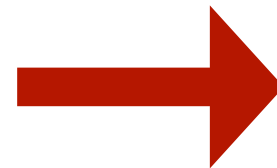


Present Simple
I **like** chocolate.



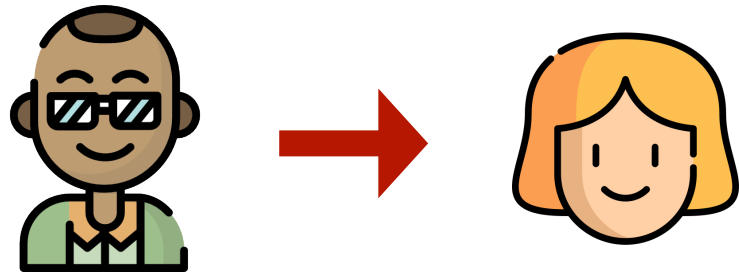
Past Simple

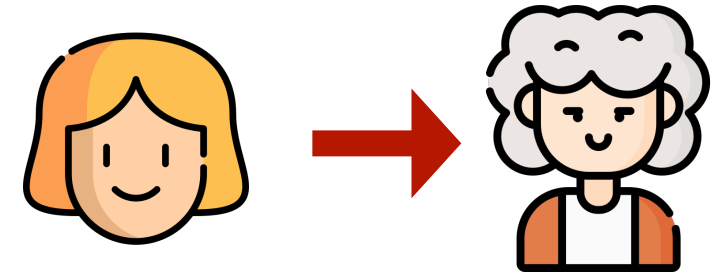
Past Simple

I **have lived** in Spain.

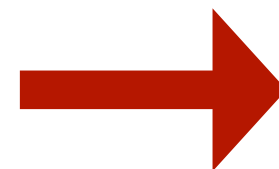

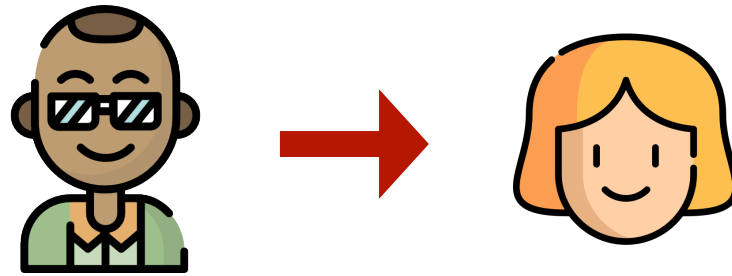


Am/Is/Are Going To
I **am going** to visit my mum later.

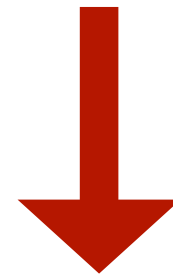


Was/Were Going To
John said he **was going** to visit his mum later.

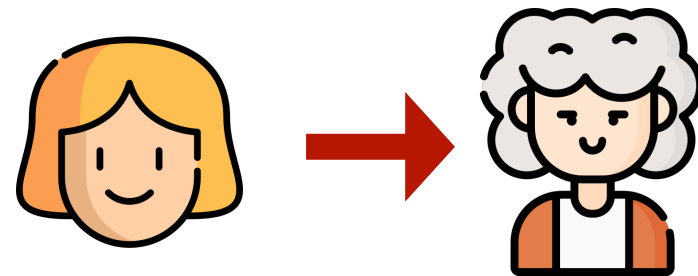

I **might** go to the party later.

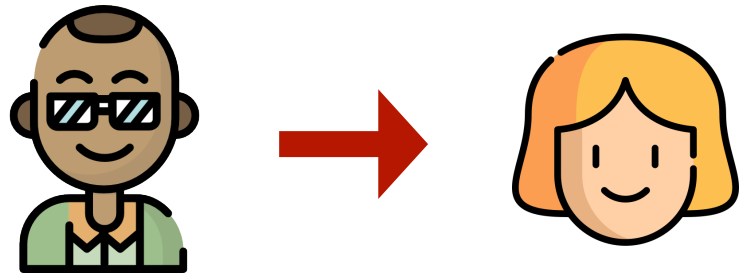

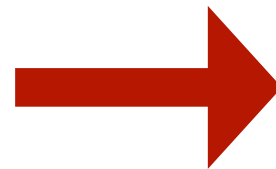

MODAL VERBS – CHANGE



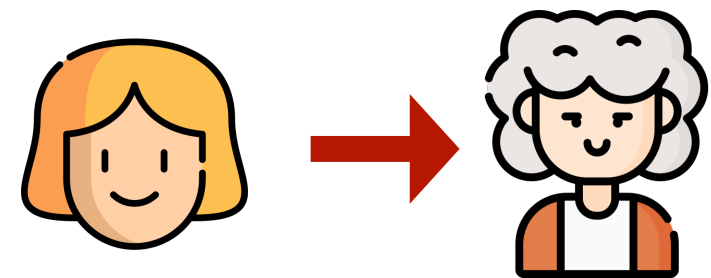
Will

I **can** help you make dinner.



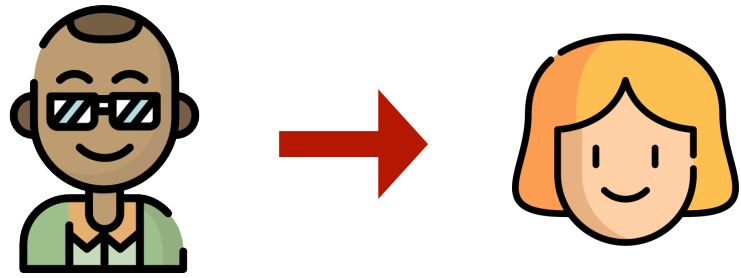
Could
