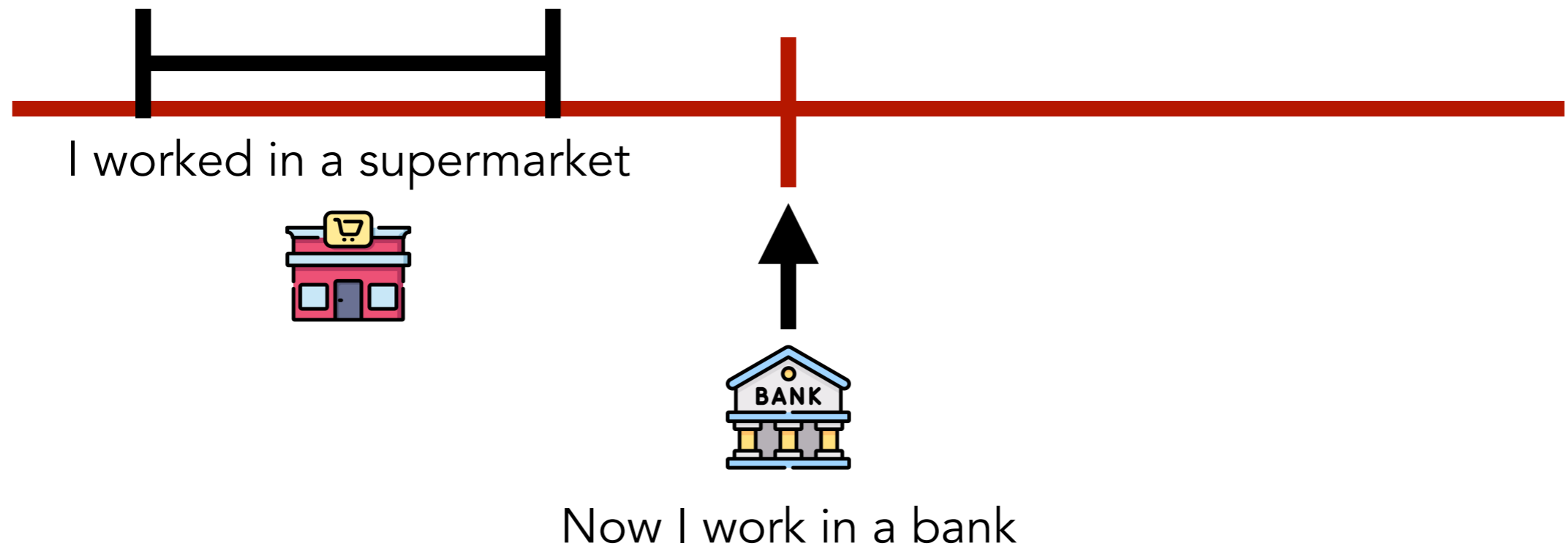

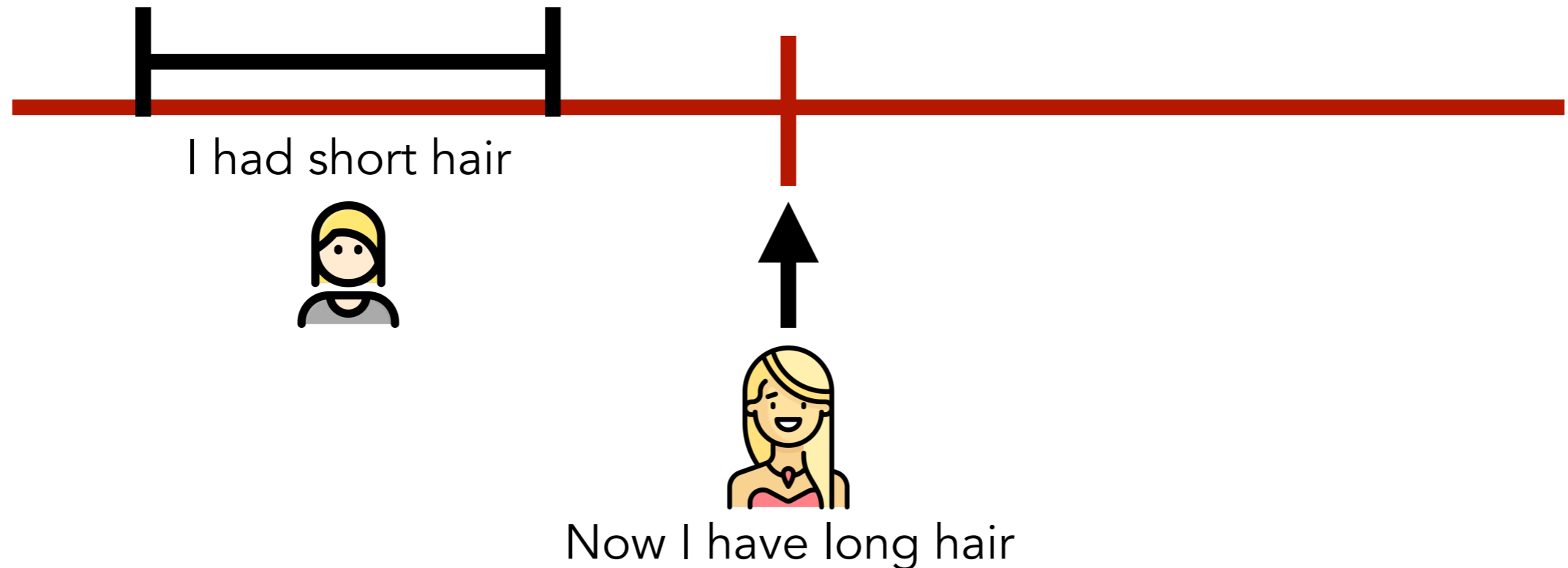

STATIVE VS DYNAMIC VERBS

Stative Verbs

- **Perceptions and sensations** (see, hear)
- **Having/Possessing and Being** (be, cost, have)
 - **Cognition and emotion** (think, feel)
- **Stance** (sit, live, stand)

Dynamic Verbs

- **Actions** (eat, drink)
